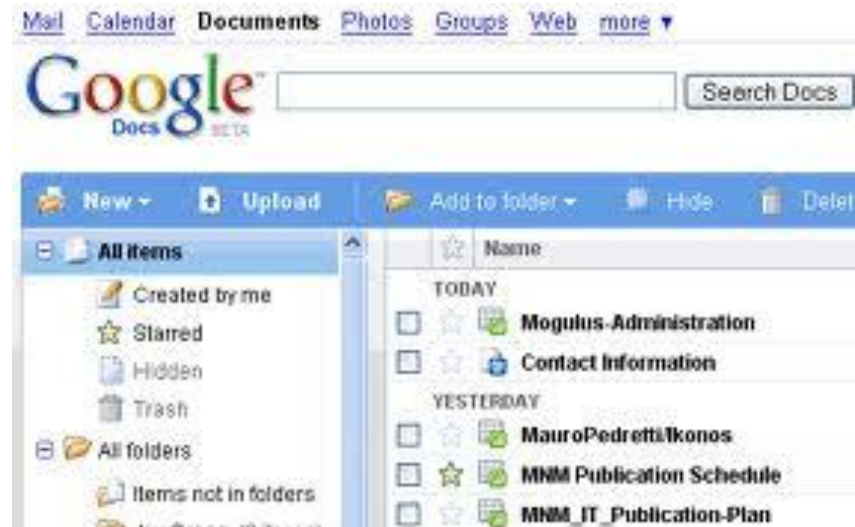

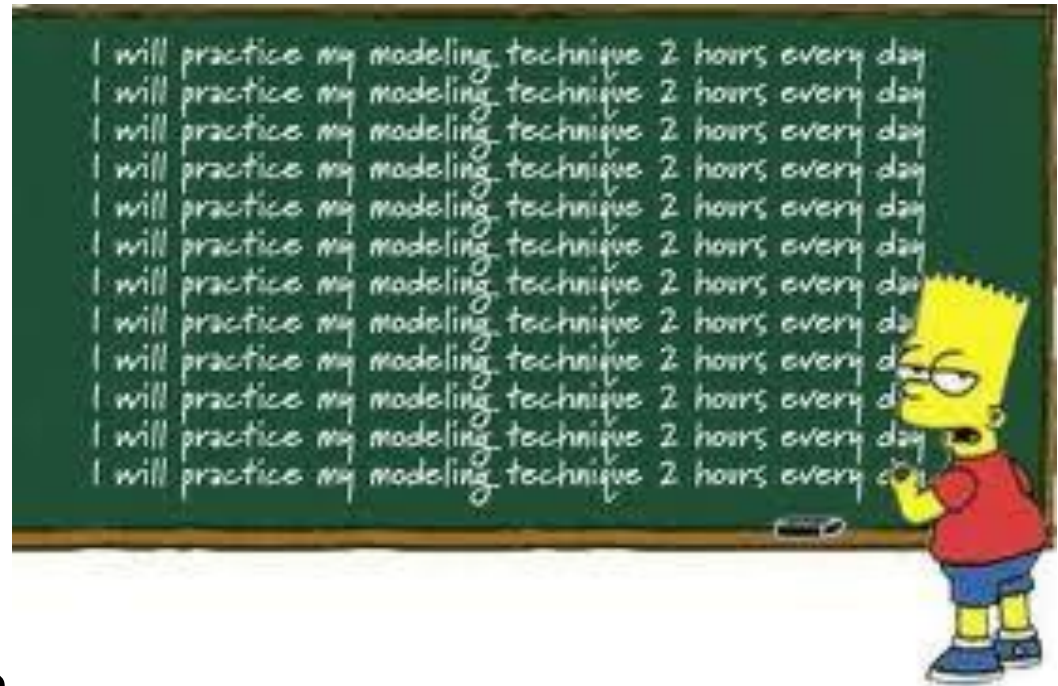
Knowledge
