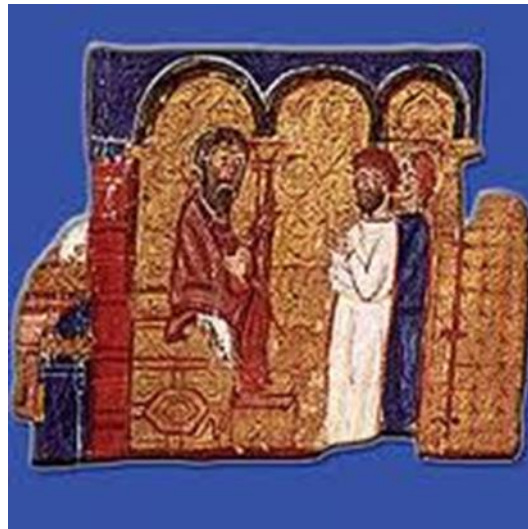
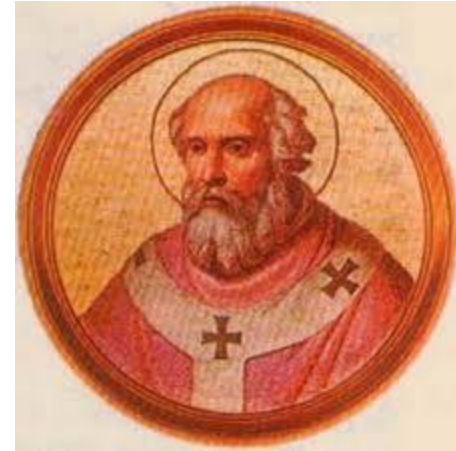

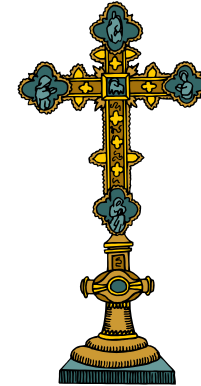
: DISCORD, DISHARMONY
