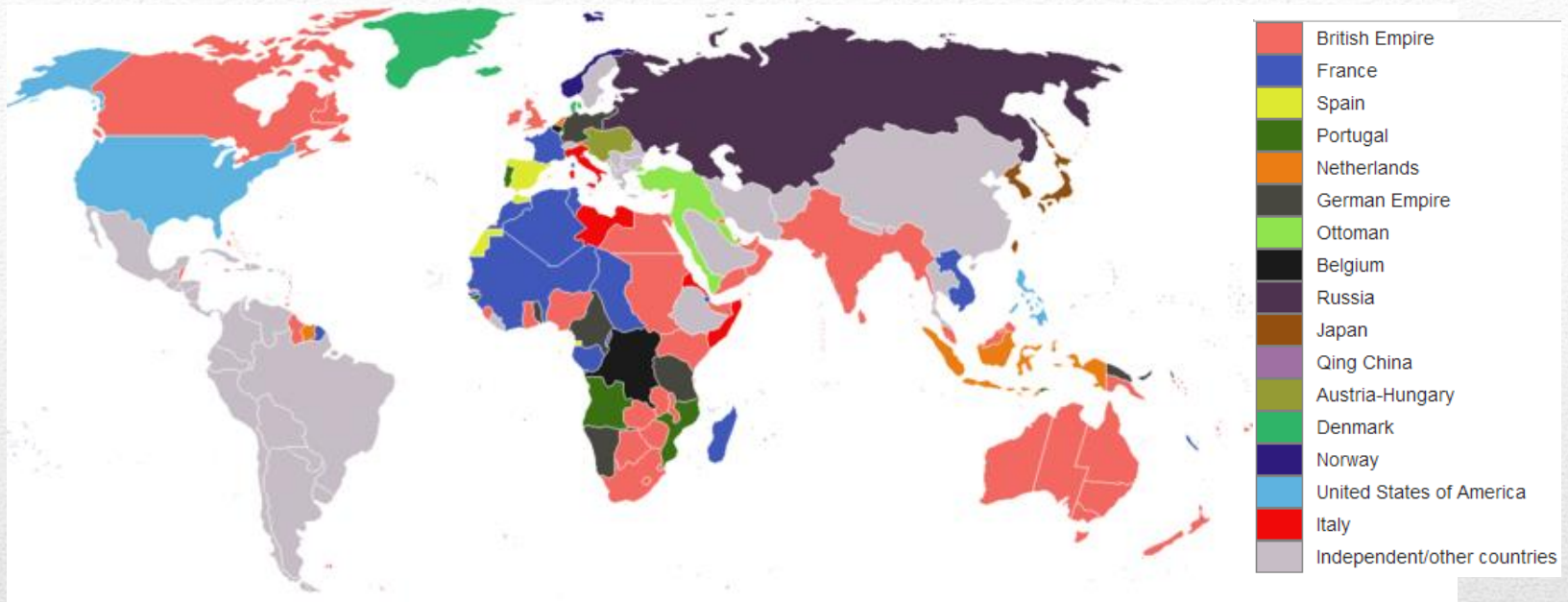

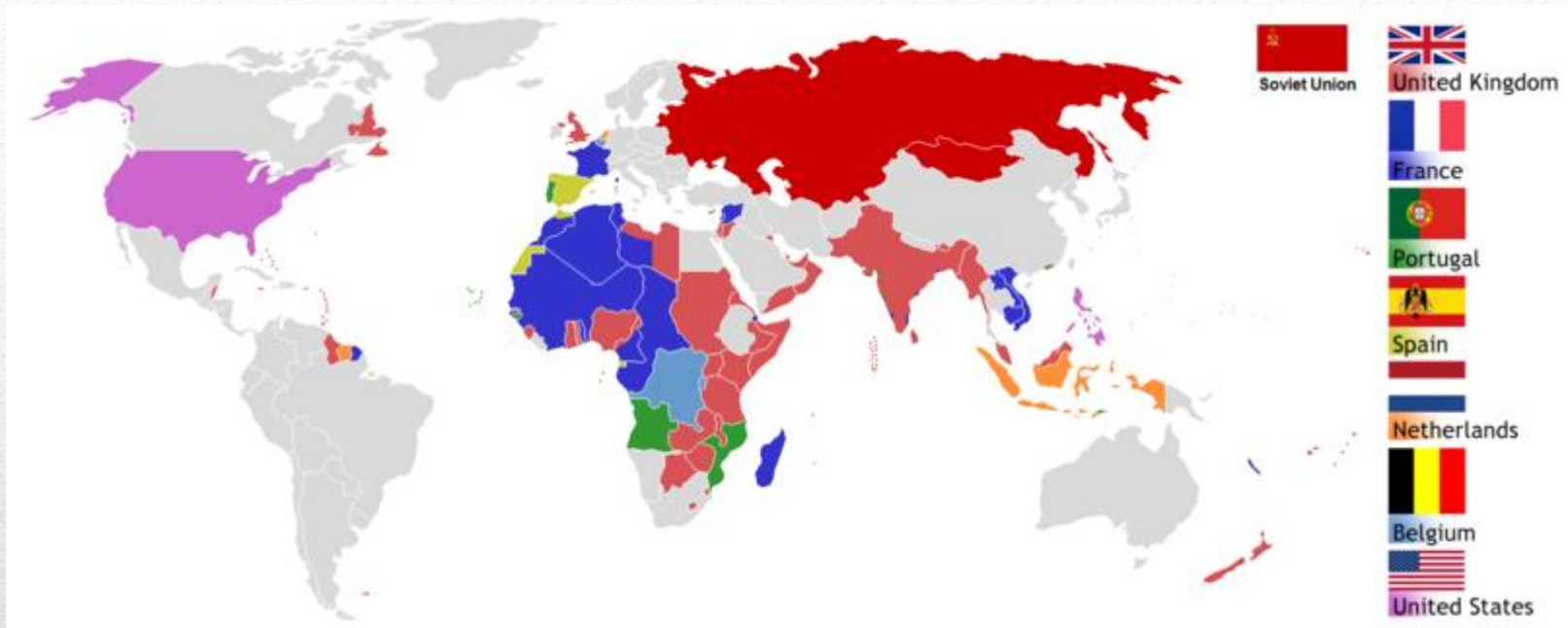

**The Superpowers-
Ideological opposites!**

- Millions so poor they can't afford food
- Little clothing for harsh climate
- No access to goods & services
- Mostly illiterate
- Little industrialization- far behind rest of Europe
- Many ethnic groups (around 100)
- War, Revolution, Depression, War...
- Wealthy landholding & controlling aristocracy
- Czar had absolute control

Understanding Ideology & Culture of Early 20th Century Russia

- End to major issues of conflict:
 - No private ownership of property
 - No need for money- we are provided for based on need
 - No ruling/wealthy class- no one special
 - No religion
 - Single culture shared by all
 - No exploitation of workers

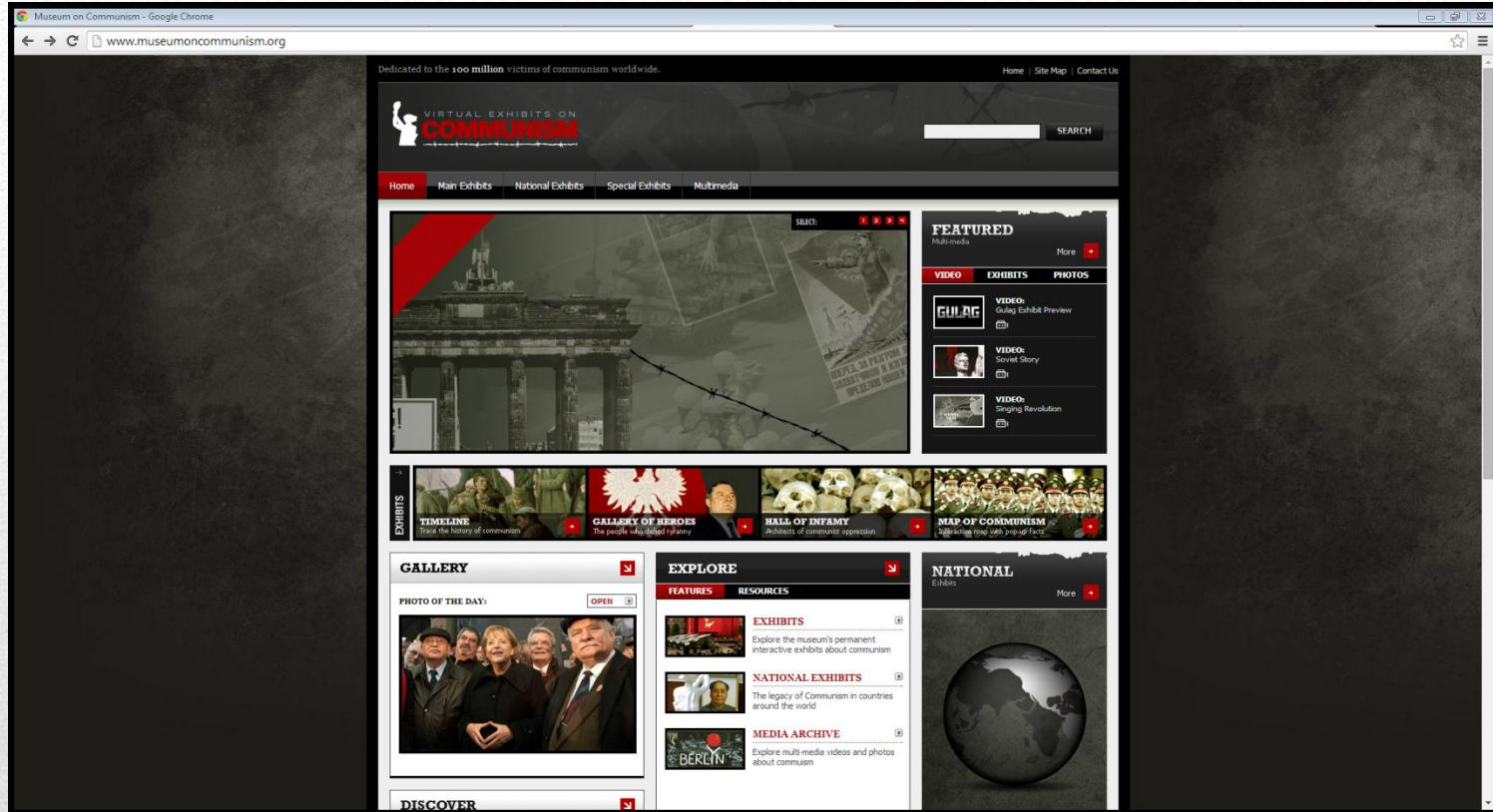
	Democracy	Communism	Fascism
Individuals and the State	Individuals' rights are more important than government interests.	Government interests are more important than individuals' rights.	Government interests are more important than individuals' rights.
Values	Freedom, individuals' rights, justice	Obedience, discipline, economic security	Obedience, discipline, national pride, military power
Government	The people and their elected representatives make decisions; control of people's lives is minimal.	Communist party makes all decisions; extreme control of all aspects of life.	Fascist party controls all aspects of life; government is permanent and necessary for national progress.
